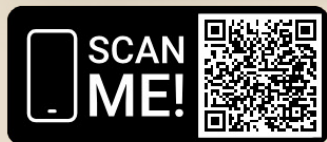


DECK THE HOUSE CONTEST

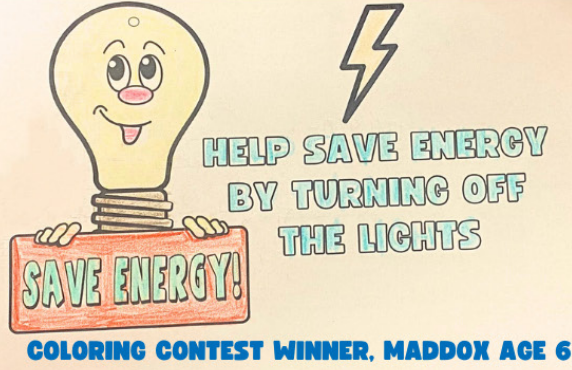
