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*\*Should the trip be cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, winners will instead receive a \$4,000 scholarship if they choose to attend a 2-year college or 4-year university!*

## Details and Itinerary:

The Government-in-Action Youth Leadership Tour 2020 is an all-expense-paid trip for high school students to learn about different aspects of the government, meet their members of Congress and visit historical sites. This year's trip will begin in Austin, Texas on Sunday, June 13 and continue on to tour sites in Washington D.C. before the trip concludes in Austin on Tuesday, June 22. Transportation between Nueces Electric Cooperative and Austin will be provided by the cooperative as well. Each winning applicant will receive the travel package, valued at \$3,000, and will join more than 120 high school students for a tour of the Texas State Capitol, Bob Bullock Texas State History Museum, the U.S. Capitol, the Supreme Court, Washington National Cathedral, Arlington National Cemetery, Smithsonian Institution and many other national sites. The travel package includes air transportation to and from Washington D.C., hotel stay, meals, admission fees, and \$250 cash for miscellaneous expenses. **PLUS: Each winner will also receive a \$1,000 scholarship, should they attend an accredited Texas college or University.**

## Eligibility and Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a high school student in junior year of high school and must not have already participated in Youth Tour through any Texas Cooperative.
2. Applicant must have consent of and reside in the home with a parent or legal guardian who is a current member of Nueces Electric Cooperative.
3. Applicant must return the completed application and essay along with a recent head and shoulder digital photo to Kirklan Hinojosa by Friday, January 15, 2021. Applications can be submitted online or via mail, email (Communications@nueceselectric.org), or fax (361.933.1178).
4. Essay must be 400-600 words in length, typed and double-spaced on the topic of: "In the past year, the COVID-19 pandemic has forced many Texans to spend more time at home than ever before. What can you do to save energy while spending more time at home?" All essays become NEC property.
5. Applications will be scored on accuracy of information, grammar, originality and content. Applicants must be able to interview in-person or via skype on Monday, January 25, 2021, if they are selected as Finalists.
6. From the group of Finalists, the Winners will be selected based on the score from their essay and their interview with a panel of judges where they will be scored based on simple knowledge of the Cooperative, knowledge of government, poise, and communication skills. (Possible interview questions will be provided to Finalists ahead of time.)
7. Each Winner must be able to participate in all aspects of the Youth Leadership Tour from June 13 - June 22, 2021, must be able to fly in an airplane and ride in a car or bus for up to 12 hours a day (with breaks).
8. Each Winner must also be able to attend the June 2021 Board of Directors Meeting as well as the October 2021 Annual Meeting (if held in person) to speak on behalf of Youth Tour to encourage others to apply.
9. The Winner's guardian must sign a waiver of release for the Winner to participate on the Youth Tour.
10. A First Runner-Up will be named to take the place of the Winner should they be unable to meet these requirements or is found to be a poor representative of the Cooperative.
